### 2 - Non-surgical centre reps

(Responsible Trustee and Chair of Council: BCS President - Professor Simon Ray to be succeeded by BCS President Elect - Professor John Greenwood from 10 June 2021)

The Council advises the Board on issues relating to cardiovascular medicine in the United Kingdom. It acts as an interface and route of communication between the Society and the Affiliated Societies. Elected members of Council represent the BCS membership at Council meetings and may be elected to represent specific constituencies (e.g. DGH cardiology and women in cardiology) or without portfolio. Elected Council members will be expected to engage in the work of Society through committees, working groups and other projects as directed by the President and Board.

One Elected member will be invited on a rolling basis to attend BCS Board and executive meetings.

Council members should be prepared for additional time commitment in this respect. Council currently meets three times per year albeit arrangements are currently under review and likely to change during 2021. At least 75% attendance required, via Teams (with occasional face to face meetings when circumstances permit), and elected members serve a term of three years.

Eligibility for standing: In order to stand for elected posts on the BCS Committee applicants must be Ordinary Members of the BCS.
